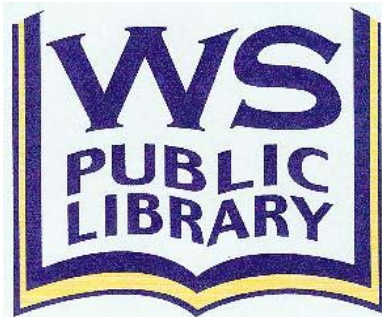


WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE PUBLIC LIBRARY RULES OF CONDUCT

Library patrons are expected to follow all Library policies, including these Rules of Conduct. Failure to do so may result in expulsion from the Library and/or loss of all Library privileges.

Prohibited Activities @ the Library

- 1. Bringing food or uncovered beverages into the Library.
Beverages are not permitted at the computer stations.**
- 2. Littering**
- 3. Loitering**
- 4. Wearing swimming attire.**
- 5. Failure to wear shirt and/or shoes.**
- 6. Making loud or disturbing noises.**
- 7. Using inline skates or skateboards on Library premises.**
- 8. Bringing in animals other than those used as service animals.**
- 9. Leaving children under the age of 10 unattended.**
- 10. Harassing staff and/or patrons.**
